Massachusetts Resident Wins a Pellet Stove and Three Tons of Wood Pellets

Generally made from recycled wood byproducts, pellets are a cost stable, low-carbon fuel that can reduce greenhouse gas emissions when used as an alternative to fossil fuels such as heating oil, propane and natural gas.

The federal government is also rewarding consumers who make the switch to clean, green heat with a tax credit. Consumers who purchase and install a qualifying pellet burning appliance before December 31, 2011 can receive a tax credit of 10 percent of the cost of the product, up to \$300.
