Alternative Energy Consumer tip: Now is the best time to purchase wood pellets

Oil pricing is on the rise again, and futures markets project continued increases through this winter, when home heating oil will take a toll on many homeowners' pockets. What's even better is that Uncle Sam will now pick up 30 percent of the cost of a new appliance through tax credit provisions in the recent Stimulus Bill.

Historically, wood pellet pricing has increased through late spring and fall as transportation fees increase and demand rises, Strimling said.

“In the past 20 years, wood pellets have remained remarkably price stable, while oil has fluctuated greatly,” Strimling said. “Not only are the oil-producing companies often in significant political and cultural conflicts, but the entire world is in great economic turmoil. With wood pellets, consumers can have peace of mind because their heating fuel costs aren't subject to foreign variables and potentially warring regimes. We aren't sure when oil price will rise, just *that* they will rise.

Fortunately, government has recognized the benefits of our local, stable energy source. There are now tax credits available to consumers for up to \$1,500, since alternative energy has become a focus of the new Presidential Administration and is benefiting from stimulus opportunities.”
